Devon & Cornwall Police warn young people about dangerous, illegal vaping liquid

The Police have seen a rise in illegal vapes, where the vape liquid has been replaced with Class B drugs THC (the active compound in cannabis) and spice (a synthetic cannabinoid). Due to the levels of these controlled substances in the vapes being unknown, the risks to teenagers taking these substances present health risks which are uncertain and have led to hospitalisations in other parts of the country.

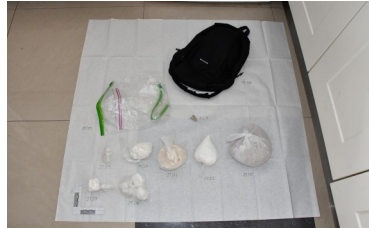

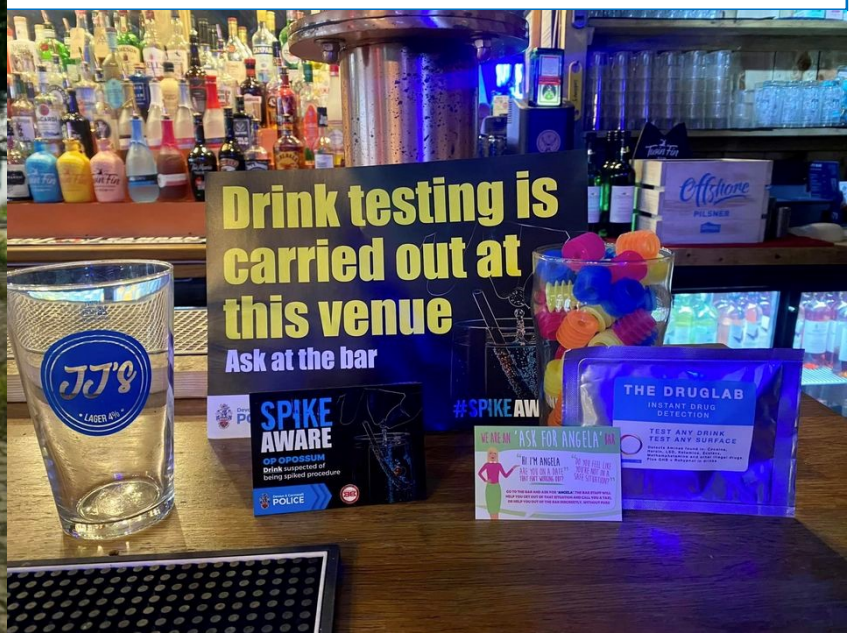

Stolen vehicle on cloned plates suspected to be in Cornwall was located and stopped in #Bude. Vehicle seized and enquiries ongoing.



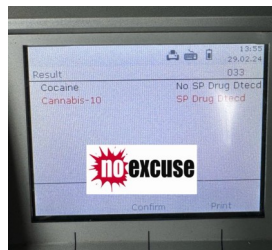

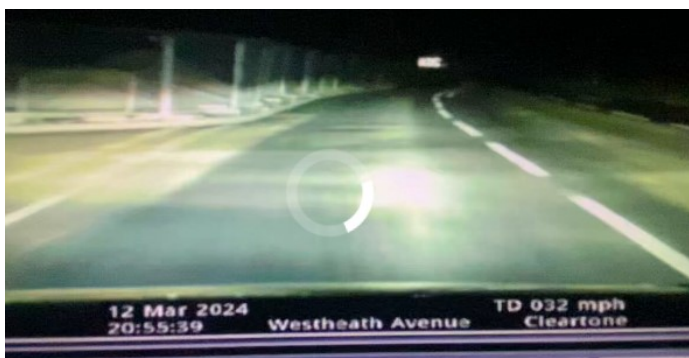

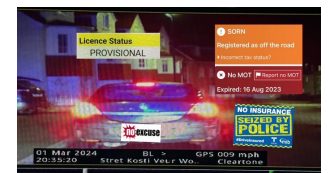
