Dear Christina,

Thank you for attending our annual parish meeting last week.

Apart from my review of the year's activities, it was clear from the outset that the main topic of discussion would be your council's proposals to move its boundary into Menheniot.

In January 2019, at its public meeting, Menheniot parish councillors voted against making any changes in its boundaries. Given that there is no evidence of a demand for change from residents of both Liskeard and Menheniot, that position remains unaltered.

A unanimous vote against your proposals was recorded at the public meeting. You were unable to justify how your proposed changes would benefit Menheniot residents. Therefore, I am writing now to give you the opportunity to withdraw your proposals completely before the submission date of 17 July 2019.

It is a condition of the governance review that all town and parish councils should state their reasons for change or no change. Irrespective of your final decision, Menheniot parish will continue to maintain its position robustly, and give clear evidence to the Review Panel and the LGBC.
