2	Schools and Community Involvement Schools – The schools are on track and liaising with artists. Dates are all sorted. Rod has had contact from 4 schools regarding the Cornish language sessions. Community workshops are scheduled for 8 th (10am – 3pm), 15 th (10am – 12 noon) and 22 nd (10am – 3pm) at the Liskerrett Centre. On 8 th the artists will be creating a large structure. Rachel will speak to Mike regarding the set up. Stewards – Sally has confirmed that the Air Cadets are all sorted. Mandy will confirm with the running groups and give firm details and request that they attend the 3pm briefing. Food – Dan has vendors lined up. He will liaise directly with Jacqui regarding the space for pitches and amount of electricity sockets available on The Parade. Entertainment – Jacqui is awaiting a response from Nic Early regarding performing on stage at 5pm. Rachel will chase him again. Sally is awaiting a response from Catseye Morris. She will chase them too. The Community Choir have a large group who will perform at the Library after the switch on and a smaller group to perform before at the Museum. Mandy will check if the Museum wish to have a different question. Rachel has already approached the Cornish Pudding Co for the cakes, next year the Library will be considered for their cakes. Usually the Library provides free drinks and the Town Council pay for the cakes. Rachel will check that Community Treasure Chest are definitely OK to take part. Fireworks – Everything is in place for the fireworks to go ahead.
