2	Schools and Community Involvement Schools – The schools are on track and Rod has 6 schools for the Cornish language sessions. Community workshops are scheduled for 8th (10am – 3pm), 15th (10am – 12 noon) and 22nd (10am – 3pm) at the Liskerrett Centre. There has been no response from the Scouts. The Brownies and Guides need to confirm numbers for their sessions.	
3	Lights Up Event PA system – Rachel and Jacqui had met Jamie on site. Mike has Jamie's contact details to liaise direct regarding the set up. Mike confirmed that his PRS Licence will cover the stage, Rainbow Circus would like to use someone's Licence. Jacqui will liaise with Dan and Sally regarding this. Nell will send Mike the list of participants and running order. Mike will liaise with the Museum and Library for further details on their events. Stewards – Mandy confirmed a minimum of 8 from Power Runs. Nothing further from the Harriers. Mandy will contact the new running group which recently received a Town Council grant to give details of the event they had offered to support. They will also be requested that someone attends the 3pm briefing. Food – Dan has 2 vendors lined up for by the Fountain. Jacqui will arrange collecting the payment of £50 from them. Mandy will check if VAT should be collected with the donation. The funds raised from these food vendors and any street collection will be ring fenced towards next year's event. Jacqui will discuss this with Yvette. Dan also has food and drink vendors arranged for the Canopy area. Sally will speak to him regarding Olive & Co being at the Canopy. End time of the event – if this needs to be tweaked for next year it can be reviewed following this event. Car Parking – performers will be advised to use the Workshed car park, social media posts will advise visitors to use Rapsons and Sungirt as well as car share.
