It was agreed to recommend that the lights are switched on as early as possible and Lights Up can focus on switching on the Christmas tree lights.

It was confirmed that Lights Up had a small group and were looking for volunteers. Jenny had sent an email asking for volunteers and confirmed that the Traders Association were invited to the meeting the following Tuesday.

## **Entertainment**

It was confirmed that for the Christmas Tree switch on Liskeard Radio could be sited outside Webbs House to broadcast. They offered to live stream events and also make a show with their roving microphone. They can coordinate musical entertainment once the Town Council has found out which groups are able to take part.
