The number of volunteers at the museum is low but we have had fresh interest and hope to gain more after an article in the Cornish Times. The small group of core volunteers have been working extremely hard to maintain the visitor experience.

The current temporary exhibition is on the wool trade in Liskeard linking with the Woolly Workshops and decoration around the town with woolly activities at the children's table.

Plans for a VE exhibition for next year are being considered subject to volunteer resources.

We have had some success in recording oral history interviews and will be looking at funding options to progress the project.

A funding application has been submitted to FEAST for a project on Emily Hobhouse working with artist Nicky Harwood.
