#### Introduction

On 12 February 2020, Cabinet approved establishment of a £4m Town Centre Revitalisation Fund Reserve to support the development of investment proposals for towns in Cornwall. The Place Shaping Framework set out a policy position for Cornwall Council which included an ambition to develop a place shaping index.

The index will enable Members and Officers to review a town's performance across various strands of economic activity. It shows which areas of a town's vitality are performing well and where there is room for improvement. This can help the Council consider targeted support and intervention and will help various services consider which towns might be best suited to any future project or service delivery.





#### Methodology

Step 1: Data was entered for 22 towns, which were profiled using 12 indicators covering the themes of Business, People-Work and Place.

Step 2: For each indicator, values were indexed to allow for consistent comparison of values across indicators in different units. The worst performing value in the dataset was set to 0 and the best performing set to 100. All other values were allocated a score between 0 and 100 based on their relative distance from the minimum and maximum dataset values.

Step 3: The scores were then weighted and totalled to provide an overall priority ranking and score for each town based on the weightings applied.





#### **Town Inclusion Criteria**

**Criteria 1: The population of the settlement's LSOA built up area must exceed 3,500 people.** This was identified as the lower population limit of a small town.

Criteria 2: The settlements MSOA population size must be no more than twice the areas LSOA population.

For each indicator data is either available at MSOA or LSOA geographies and in some cases both. In this case the LSOA populations are the more appropriate geography for the index as the boundaries more closely fit the a town geography. Some data is however only available at the larger geographical level (MSOA) which creates problems as some MSOAs cover vast areas much less relevant to settlement of focus. In order to prevent the creation of a false profile, a MSOA limit of twice the population size of the LSOA boundary has been applied.

**Criteria 3: The settlement must provide significant facilities for the local and surrounding population.** Significant in this sense includes a town centre, educational and health facilities. It should be included in the list of towns defined as such by the ONS\*.

\*Bodmin, Bude, Camborne, Falmouth, Hayle, Helston, Launceston, Liskeard, Looe, Newquay, Penzance, Redruth, Saltash, St. Austell, St. Blazey, St. Ives, Torpoint, Truro, Wadebridge. The only additional town in the list is Penryn which ONS include under Falmouth but has been included due to its fulfilment of the criteria in its own right.



Please Note: A settlement must meet all three of these criteria to be included as a town in the vitality index.

#### What about our Rural Communities?

- The importance of our rural areas is recognised through the recent Rural and Coastal Communities Member Inquiry such as recommended action or focus in the following areas:
  - Physical connectivity of rural and coastal areas
  - Digital connectivity of rural and coastal areas
  - Development of new workspaces in rural and coastal areas where need is identified
- There is an ambition to investigate the creation of something similar to this Town index for our rural areas
- Data will be a challenge at a rural level but this can be investigated
- We need to be sure that a rural index will give us information and intelligence that we don't already
  have and offers an economic outlook to feed into place based decision making

The aim is to use and implement the Economic Town Vitality Index to inform place shaping work, economic growth and spatial targeting. It will evolve as new and relevant data sets become available for inclusion. Annual reports can be provided to update on developments.
