Dear Town Council,

Firstly, please accept my apologies for any dismay that may have been caused by the letter sent on Wednesday 1 March. The intention was to ensure that you had notice prior to the publication of the public facing documents which had been prepared for Neighbourhood Overview and Scrutiny Committee which had reference to the provision and delivery of CCTV.

As I committed to in my original letter; I reiterate that we are not looking to implement the six-month break clause within the contracts and I also reiterate my assurance that we will continue to monitor at Service Headquarters, Tolvaddon throughout 2023-2024.

We will be working with the CCTV management group and individual towns to ensure continuation of appropriate provision through this period. We also recognise that some towns may wish to move to alternative provisions, and we will facilitate this.

It is however important that we do consider the findings within the business case about the costs that the service is currently absorbing to deliver the CCTV provision and look to mitigate these appropriately. Cornwall Council needs to ensure cost recovery for all income generation activity it undertakes.

Please also feel free to extend this information to additional members of your town and parish councils should they wish to attend.
