<b>1</b>	<p><b>Welcome</b></p> <p>Rachel Brooks welcomed everyone to the meeting and the group introduced themselves.</p>	
<b>2</b>	<p><b>Events and Activities</b></p> <p>The group worked through the draft list of events and noted the resources available from previous years and the events which have been registered on the HOD website. There were some items which would not be going ahead for various reasons and finer details were added to others pending receipt of their Registration Forms. Mandy had contacted some of the venues to check if they wished to participate this year and was awaiting responses. She will also contact the Methodist Church again to see if they wish to take part.</p> <p>It was noted that the Cattle Market area won't be ready in time. Rachel Br will ask Bradys if they would open as supervised visits as they have done as part of the Open Sites Programme. The Produce Market and stalls would need to be on The Parade. Jenny will do a Registration Form. Brian will check with the Museum if the sheep shearing machine could be displayed.</p> <p>The B&amp;W film won't be available for the Liskerrett Centre in time for the event. Jenny will send Mandy details to for the Public Hall Registration Form and produce an exhibition about the town's cinemas which can be displayed there or at the Public Hall. She will confirm if the Centre will be open during the event.</p> <p>The Masonic Hall form was received from Eric. The St Martin's Lodge will have exhibitions of the Lodge's history and the stained glass. They will provide light refreshments.</p> <p>It was agreed to take up the offer from Aaron Upton to use his drone to take aerial photos. These would be matched with older photos and displayed at A1 size. There are suitable photos from 1930 on the Heritage England website and these are available free of charge if not being used for commercial gain. Brian will also check the Museum's photos and Rachel will ask the Cornish Times about those used in a feature previously. Light refreshments will also be available. The Hall will host the exhibition boards from properties not taking part this year, the aerial photograph exhibition and possibly the history of the town's cinemas exhibition.</p> <p>Rachel Be will continue to liaise with the Museum to prevent Stuart House duplicating information on the Man Engine. Rachel Be will also investigate including original old photographs in the exhibition which Brian mentioned.</p> <p>Rachel Be and Brian will send Mandy photos of the town's ironworks. These can be used for an exhibition and in the event publicity. Brian could also do the Moorswater part of his ironworks talk.</p> <p>Mary volunteered to help at the Pipe Well. Mandy will send her the photos from the last event and the outfits worn. She will also add some photos to the display boards from Tregantle which will form part of the Public Hall event.</p> <p>Brian will investigate if it is possible to take any photos of Hollywood to be included at the Public Hall. He will also confirm with Westbourne House their details.</p> <p>Rachel Br will check the position with Trehawke House.</p> <p>Alec joined the meeting at this point.
