### **Narrative:**

#### **Adult committee:**

The committee AGM was held on the 20<sup>th</sup> November. During this meeting it was agreed that subject to youth approval, the project would focus on delivering a high standard Friday night provision as

funding for Wednesday nights would currently only stretch for a few months. Funding focus for the upcoming year was agreed as Children in Need to be submitted in March, alongside some smaller grants (YAC Small Grants, Smile Centre (health related) and police ASB-prevention funding). The decision to take full financial responsibility for the upcoming year was voted in.

### **Youth club:**

This month we have facilitated; games nights, Arts and crafts, Cooking evenings, and interactive sessions. We have also incorporated a number of Issue based sessions into these, cooking enables young people to learn independence skills and we talk around healthy eating, Mental Health sessions, LGBT+ discussions and have been planning for trips/activities for the New year Brook was planned to come in but due to illness was postponed, until the new year 2019.

We also ran an open Halloween Party, which was well attended by young people and community members.

Music continues to run on a Friday night with a local volunteer. With a core group of young people spending their session learning guitar and drums.

We have built up a good number of volunteers now, with 1 facilitating music, 1 attending drop-ins and supporting, 1 in the process of going through application, we also have had a Young People Cornwall apprentice at sessions, who is local to Liskeard and training to be a youth worker.

Youth workers attend the safer Liskeard meetings, Latest reports are that they have very few problems at present with young people. However meeting have discussed some possible partnership work and facilitating some outreach particularly around Castle park.

One young person from the youth club we arranged to take part in the national initiative Takeover Day and worked with Sally Hawken 'taking over' her job for the day!
