Narrative:

Adult committee:

The steering group have been successful in getting £10,000 through the awards for all bid, we had currently put one evening on hold whilst awaiting this result, so this will enable us to continue with two evenings a week. The funding will support one evening a week for a year.

The Children in Need bid has been started and will be submitted for the September deadline.

A bid has also been submitted for Co-op's Community fund, if picked to go through to the next stage, we will get 1% from co-op member sales in Liskeard, funding will be allocated in May 2019.

We now have a working group of 4 committee members, 3 of which are parents of young people, as well as a town council and youth work representative attending sessions.

1 committee member has now started volunteering in the youth centre.

Through YPC, VCSE project, members will be upskilling themselves through a number of level 2 course that can be accessed for free, this will further benefit work with young people in Liskeard.

Youth steering group:

Although the Wednesday nights aren't happening the Friday nights still have a focus on youth participation and engaging young people in planning, they are still working towards hosting another silent disco, creating logos for the youth club and fundraising.

2 young people attended the Liskeard town forum to speak about the youth project.

2 young people have shown an interest in becoming volunteers YPC are currently developing a youth champion scheme which will see these young people take part in basic training, and be certificated for their volunteer hours and contributions.

Youth club:

July 1st – July 31st

In July we have had 37 individual young people attending youth sessions.

Sessions continue to engage young people in a number of positive activities, including, cooking(smoothies, soup and pancakes), games, arts, sports and music, we even had a magic evening!

Youth workers have seen over 100 young people whilst doing outreach to promote the youth club around the town, local parks and at the fair.

Music lessons being run by one of the volunteers continue on a Friday night with an average group of 5yp engaging.

Co-op continue to support the youth club through food donations to the group.

We have also engaged with the Junk food Project, RIO, Cornwall Council, and local churches to run a partnership project over the summer holidays, running healthy living/eating workshop with games and activities. £3,800 funding has been gained through the Filling the Holiday Gap funding scheme which will be split between a number of partners to run different activities.

We continue to attend Safer Liskeard meetings although the last one was postponed.
