

## **Liskeard Town Council Carbon audit brief**

Liskeard Town Council would like to commission a carbon audit to establish baseline data, provide information which will enable us to set targets on becoming net carbon neutral, and identify practical action which can be taken locally to achieve this.

Please set out how you could meet this brief, with the following parameters:

### **Geographical area to be covered**

Please provide costings for two options for the area to be covered:

- The geographical parish of Liskeard
- The whole Liskeard-Looe Community network area, which includes 18 parishes.

### **What to include**

The audit should include direct energy use in the area, with a focus on heating, lighting, transport (including public transport) and agriculture. Please set out specifically what will be included.

It should also include the option for an initial assessment around consumption/carbon embedded in imported goods.

### **Who it covers**

It should cover residents and private, voluntary and public sector organisations, including Liskeard Town Council itself. It should not include Cornwall Council activity (already covered by their own audit) or that of other large public sector organisations we are unlikely to be able to influence.

### **Focus on practical action**

The audit should include specific recommendations for where and how the area can make the biggest impact in reducing its carbon footprint.

It should also include recommendations on the potential for local renewable generation from solar and wind power
