## **EDG1826 Woodgate Road & Old Road, Liskeard – Pedestrian Crossings & Footpath**

Cormac Solutions Ltd on behalf of Cornwall Council is inviting comments on a proposal to provide an additional footpath and crossing points along Woodgate Road and Old Road Liskeard.

Following the residential development on the northern side of Woodgate Road, Cornwall Council has secured a s106 contribution from the developer. This contribution will look to provide an additional footway and crossing points in and around the areas of Woodgate Road and Old Road.

The proposal is to include:

- One flat top road hump and crossing point on Old Road, east of the mini-roundabout;
- One flat top road hump and crossing point on Old Road, north of the mini-roundabout;
- One flat top road hump and crossing point on Woodgate Road.
- A new pedestrian footpath across the verge on north side of Old Road.

Whether or not the scheme goes ahead will depend on (a) the outcome of the consultation, and (b) the findings of the feasibility study that is currently being carried out for the Community Network Panel (CNP).
