What does your organisation do?	We are the Local Committee of Cancer Research UK and raise money for what is the world's leading cancer research charity dedicated to saving lives through research, influence and information.

How is your organisation funded?	We raise money from various events. Any expenses are taken from the gross amount raised before monies are sent to the Cancer Research UK head office.
Give a brief description of your project.	The Annual Exhibition & Sale of Art & Craft in Liskeard is our main project and largest fundraising event. The 2024 Exhibition will be our 55 th . We plan to set up the hanging screens in the Main Hall and bring in our equipment on Saturday 2 March. The following day the exhibitors hand in their exhibits and we begin hanging the pictures. On the Monday the craft displays are arranged and the entries typed for the catalogue. The Opening Evening with wine and cheese is on the Tuesday. The Exhibition is then open

every day until the Sunday. We serve refreshments every day and run a successful raffle. We display literature relating to various cancers. What benefits will your project The Annual Exhibition & Sale of Art & Craft provides a venue for give to the town, visibly or in the local artists and crafts people. It is the largest event of its kind in impact that the project will have East Cornwall and extremely well supported by exhibitors and the general public. We know from people who talk to us that a large number are personally affected by cancer. The 54th Exhibition raised £11,300. The Exhibition also provides an opportunity for social interaction contributing to the well being of local residents. The refreshments are very popular. The St Just Local Committee holds an Annual Art Exhibition. This is held in August to attract visitors. It is different in that exhibits can be taken on purchase whereas our exhibits stay on display until the close of the Exhibition.

What is the total cost of your Project?	The normal total cost of the Exhibition includes the hire of rooms and facilities in the Public Hall (the indicative quote for 2024 is £2233.20), printing costs (approximately £1200 with further printing paid for by Cancer Research UK head office), refreshments (approximately £500 with some food donated) plus some postage and stationery and incidental expenses although some of these are donated.
	The Council cannot fund the normal ongoing operating costs of organisations. This application should not contain such costs.
What sum of money are you looking for from the Town Council?	We are looking for a Grant of £838 to cover the rising costs of hiring the Public Hall since 2022 being £526 in 2023 and £312 in 2024.
What exactly will it be used to support?	The work of Cancer Research UK.
How will the rest of your project be funded?	By deduction from the money raised from the Exhibition before sending funds to Cancer Research UK Head Office.
