Info sent to each company:

The details I normally have for the Remembrance Day Parade are:

- Dates & times of the event (the time you need the road closed and clear of traffic) Sunday 12th November. The closure would start at 10.25am, with the Parade to the War Memorial and Church between 10.30am 11.10am. The return journey would be 12 noon 12.30pm.
- Route of parade/closure (Start & end points and the route to be taken) The usual route of the Parade is to assemble at the former Cattle Market car park and travel along The Parade, Castle Street and up to the War Memorial, then on to St Martin's Church. The return route is back to the former Cattle Market car park, minus the War Memorial.
- Do any buses run on the route of the closure and what are their numbers? I've checked the website for this Sunday as the timetables may well change by November. The 11 and 73 busses run, but are outside of the closure times. https://www.gocornwallbus.co.uk/services. It appears that the National Express bus would be affected by this if their timetable is the same in November Normally the bus companies receive letters informing them of the closure.
- Are there parking (including disabled), taxi, or loading bays along the route that need to be suspended during the closure? On The Parade there are pull in parking bays for approx. 3 cars and a buss stop on each side and a taxi rank for 2 taxis outside Lloyds Bank. I'm pretty sure that there are no disabled bays.
