Ref: Footpath from Old Road to New Road

Dear Cllr Powell,

I am writing as chair of Liskeard Town Forum, which is a non-political body made up of residents and organisations with a shared ambition around the prosperity of Liskeard.

As you are probably aware Liskeard Town Forum agreed to support work to improve the paths and cycle ways around Liskeard. This works alongside the aims and objectives identified by the Communications and Engagement Committee of LTC.

A resolution at the Forum was passed to support improvements to the footpath link between Old Road and New Road at the bottom of Moorswater. At the moment the path from Old Road to New Road finishes with steps, which make them impractical to those with mobility scooters, bikes and prams. (See image below). The hill up old road is steep and impractical. The steps and steep hill could limit access to Moorswater.

I am writing to ask if the Planning committee can consider noting support for an improvement to the footpath between Old Road and New Road at Moorswater, and whether at the next round of Highways Funding for local projects, if planning would consider putting this on the list of considerations?
