Re. The parking problems at the entrance to Magnolia Court – photographs enclosed

Magnolia Court is a small block of nine flats situated at the rear of shops in Baytree Hill. A private car park for the use of residents is at the front of the building and the entrance to it is via a narrow alleyway between two shops. Double yellow lines are painted on Baytree Hill across the entrance to this alleyway. Despite these yellow lines motorists often park their cars either completely or partially across the alleyway rendering it impossible for residents to drive out of the car park. With the narrowness of the alleyway there is no room for manoeuvre. The main problem is caused by the hour of free parking allowed in spaces on each side of the entrance. Too many motorists try to park in the spaces simultaneously which invariably results in encroachment onto the double yellow lines. There are two large public car parks in the centre of the town.

The enclosed photographs were taken last Sunday. This car was parked from late on Saturday evening until 3.15pm on Sunday afternoon. Frustrated residents called the police eventually to have it moved.

Would it be possible to have a 'KEEP CLEAR' sign painted on the road where the double yellow lines are or even a bollard placed at each end of these lines? With the ever increasing volume of traffic in the town and the opening of Weatherspoons on the Parade the problem is worsening considerably.

Any assistance you can give in this matter would be very much appreciated by all residents.
