How are you funded?	<p>We receive the majority of our income via our guests fees. We also have an ongoing fundraising programme in order to support the work that we undertake with disabled people and carers. Funds are sourced from a variety of funding streams including Trusts and Foundations, local authorities, individual donors, corporate partners, legacy bequests and a calendar of fundraising events. We work extremely hard to secure donations in order to reach as many disabled people and their carers as we can across the UK, therefore grants like this are vital for our service.</p>
What benefits will your project give to the town, visibly or in the Community? Who in the Town will benefit?	<p>Directly, this grant will benefit a disabled person from Liskeard, helping us to provide them with a break at one of our centres. Indirectly, this grant will provide a break to the family and friends that provide support to them.</p> <p>96% of disabled people and carers believe that respite breaks are essential to sustaining strong and healthy relationships, and our breaks make a great impact on our guests.</p> <p>A guest from Liskeard will benefit from an improvement in their wellbeing, improved relationships with their carer/family and friends that support them, and a reduction in any feelings of isolation and loneliness they may have.</p>
A brief description of your project	<p>96% of disabled people and carers think breaks are essential to sustaining strong, functional and healthy caring relationships.</p> <p>Our bespoke breaks address the obstacles of affordability, accessibility and carer guilt, ensuring our guests experience a socially inclusive environment, helping them to tackle the</p>



	<p>barriers they face in their everyday lives. We provide reassurances to those who need 24 hour nurse led care, catering for all disabilities at our three fully accessible centres in Essex, Southampton and Southport. All of our centres are registered as 'Good' with the Care Quality Commission and provide all inclusive accommodation including en-suite wet rooms, along with equipment such as hoists and profiling beds. Each centre offers its breaks in a relaxed, holiday-style environment, with every seven night break including four accessible excursions.</p> <p>At Revitalise, carers are able to join their loved ones at our centres for a break together. However, 85% of carers have some time to themselves away from the centre, knowing that their loved ones are safe, happy and being cared for. Carers have often described our service as a 'life-saver.'</p>
