Subject: Gas lane, Liskeard - parking concern

I would like to bring to the attention of the Liskeard Town Council concerns raised by residents living in the area of Gas Lane. As the photographs clearly show vehicles are parking on a very regular basis at the entrance to Gas Lane. In the event of an emergency vehicle such as a fire engine needing to attend a fire in any of the properties only accessible via Gas Lane; their access is impeded. Often cars are parked on the other side of this narrow entrance directly next to the boundary wall of Elnor Guest House and this causes just the same problem for access. I would like the Town Council to consider parking restrictions such as a single yellow line or a double yellow line to extend into Gas Lane from its junction with Lanchard Lane; including the full boundary wall of Elnor Guest House where it is opposite a junction for Garth Morcom. This situation has developed over many years and has worsened since the introduction of nearby parking restrictions being introduced in Lanchard Lane. I hope the Town Council could give our suggestion serious thought and consideration.
