Update since 26th February 2018

End of Year Statistics

As you will see from the attached table, visitor numbers in February and March were lower than at the same time last year but overall annual visitor numbers were up 6% and at their highest level since 2011. This is undoubtedly due to the popularity of the displays in the museum drawing in greater numbers of visitors.

Ticket sales were considerably lower as several popular events, including Air Day, did not take place this year. However, gift sales were up 28%, membership was up 40% and our overall profit was 25% higher than last year. This year, for the first time, customers spent the same amount using card payments as via cash sales.

Completed Apprenticeships
