The above Order was made by Cornwall Council on 19th March 2026. On 12th May 2026 Cornwall Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed will divert a length of Public Footpath Number 22 in the Parish of Liskeard commencing at its junction with part of Public Footpath 22 Liskeard to be retained approximately 96 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SX 26246/63815 shown as point 'A' on the Order map then continuing in a generally east-south-easterly direction for a distance of 1.5 metres terminating at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 15 Menheniot to be extinguished by this Order approximately 98 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26247/63815 shown as point 'B' on the attached map. Then to divert a length of Public Footpath Number 15 in the Parish of Menheniot commencing at its junction with part of Public Footpath 22 Liskeard to be extinguished by this Order approximately 98 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26247/63815 shown as point 'B' on the attached map then continuing in a generally east-south-easterly direction for a distance of 160 metres terminating at its junction with Public Footpath 15 Menheniot to be retained approximately 256 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26404/63784 shown as point 'D' on the attached map revised to a length of Public Footpath in the Parish of Liskeard commencing at its junction with part of Public Footpath 22 Liskeard to be retained approximately 96 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SX 26246/63815 shown as point 'A' on the attached Order map then continuing in a generally south-

south-easterly direction for a distance of 60 metres terminating at its junction with another Public Footpath to be created by this Order in the Parish of Menheniot approximately 142 metres south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26277/63765 shown as point 'C' on the attached map and a length of Public Footpath in the Parish of Menheniot commencing at its junction with another Public Footpath to be created by this Order in the Parish of Liskeard approximately 142 metres south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26277/63865 shown as point 'C' on the attached map then continuing in a generally south-south-easterly direction then east-north-easterly direction for a distance of 155 metres terminating at its junction with Public Footpath 15 Menheniot to be retained approximately 256 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26404/63784 shown as point 'D' on the attached map.

**THE CORNWALL COUNCIL PUBLIC FOOTPATH 22 LISKEARD (PART) AND PUBLIC
FOOTPATH 15 MENHENIOT (PART) (LAND AT TENCREEK FARM) PUBLIC PATH
DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

THIS ORDER is made by Cornwall Council ('the Authority') under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the Public Footpath to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: PA22/06825 : 'Hybrid application for development of land for employment-generating uses.'

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The Public Footpath over the land situated at 'Tencreek Farm' in the Parishes of Liskeard and Menheniot shown by a continuous bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be diverted as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Cornwall Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said Public Footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold black dashes on the attached map.
3. The diversion of the Public Footpath shall have effect on the date on which Cornwall Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
4. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule:
 - Construction of a 2-metre-wide path using block paving material along the whole length of the alternative highway described in article 2 above except where existing hard surfaces will be retained.
5. The applicant is hereby required to pay for the cost of carrying out the said works.
6. Where immediately before the date on which the Public Footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
7. This Order may be cited as, "The Cornwall Council Public Footpath 22 Liskeard (Part) and Public Footpath 15 Menheniot (Part) (Land at Tencreek Farm) Public Path Diversion Order 2026".

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A length of Public Footpath Number 22 in the Parish of Liskeard commencing at its junction with part of Public Footpath 22 Liskeard to be retained approximately 96 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SX 26246/63815 shown as point 'A' on the attached Order map then continuing in a generally east-south-easterly direction for a distance of 1.5 metres terminating at its junction with a part of Public Footpath 15 Menheniot to be extinguished by this Order approximately 98 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26247/63815 shown as point 'B' on the attached map.

A length of Public Footpath Number 15 in the Parish of Menheniot commencing at its junction with part of Public Footpath 22 Liskeard to be extinguished by this Order approximately 98 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26247/63815 shown as point 'B' on the attached map then continuing in a generally east-south-easterly direction for a distance of 160 metres terminating at its junction with Public Footpath 15 Menheniot to be retained approximately 256 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26404/63784 shown as point 'D' on the attached map.

The Definitive Statement does not record a width for Public Footpath 22 Liskeard or Public Footpath 15 Menheniot. For the avoidance of doubt the intention of this Order is to stop up the lengths of Public Footpath described above in their entirety.

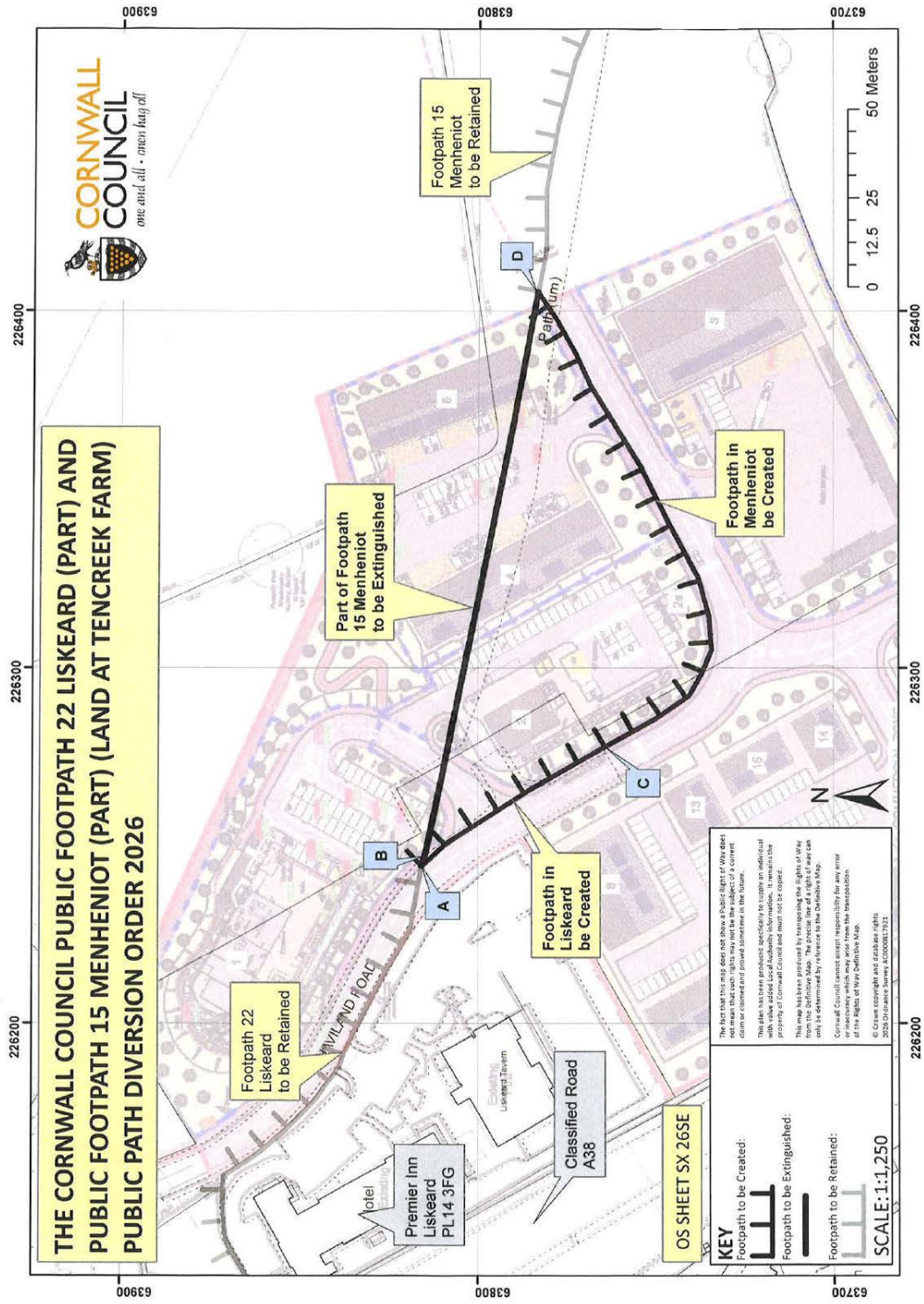

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF ALTERNATIVE HIGHWAY

A length of Public Footpath in the Parish of Liskeard commencing at its junction with part of Public Footpath 22 Liskeard to be retained approximately 96 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SX 26246/63815 shown as point 'A' on the attached Order map then continuing in a generally south-south-easterly direction for a distance of 60 metres terminating at its junction with another Public Footpath to be created by this Order in the Parish of Menheniot approximately 142 metres south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26277/63765 shown as point 'C' on the attached map.

A length of Public Footpath in the Parish of Menheniot commencing at its junction with another Public Footpath to be created by this Order in the Parish of Liskeard approximately 142 metres south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26277/63865 shown as point 'C' on the attached map then continuing in a generally south-south-easterly direction then east-north-easterly direction for a distance of 155 metres terminating at its junction with Public Footpath 15 Menheniot to be retained approximately 256 metres east-south-east of 'Premier Inn, Liskeard' at OSGR SX 26404/63784 shown as point 'D' on the attached map.

The Public Footpaths described above shall have a width of 2.0 (two) metres throughout.
