1	<p>Welcome</p> <p>Rachel welcomed Eve and everyone introduced themselves.</p>	
2	<p>Schools Programme</p> <p>The initial sessions at schools had started with 9 schools booked, although none had yet signed up to the Programme. Golden Tree will send the Town Council the invitation/details for them to contact the schools to encourage participation, particularly St Martin's and Hillfort. Rebecca will contact Charlotte Jones and to encourage her school's participation and copy in Mandy and Golden Tree to responses. She will also send Mandy and Golden Tree Danny Tower's Academy contact details.</p> <p>The schools who have signed up to the Taster Sessions are: Darite, Harrowbarrow, Liskeard SCC, Menheniot, Pensilva, St Neot, Trenode, Trewidland and Upton Cross.</p> <p>Rachel had spoken to Jackie Long who was interested in the programme, Joe will make contact with her. 3	<p>Lanterns</p> <p>Mark has 4 schools signed up, 6/7 schools are needed. There will also be public sessions at the Liskerrett Centre on Saturdays.</p> <p>A FEAST bid has been submitted to help fund a town-like lantern display at the Cattle Market car park.</p>	
4	<p>Funding</p> <p>Rachel requested that Golden Tree give costings for the event by the beginning of November to help the Town Council with future budgeting, Mandy will send Jo a list of items which may be involved. After this year's event an asset pack will be handed over from Golden Tree to the Town Council and the Town Council will have ownership of this going forward.</p>	<p>GT MH</p>
5	<p>Trail and Window Dressing</p> <p>Jen Dyer is the practitioner who has been commissioned by Golden Tree to work with the schools, she will also remove the displays from the shops and return them to the respective school. A date has been set for the</p>	

	<p>removal. There will be a template to link the display and the language as part of the asset pack. The questions have been tweaked to be more seasonal.</p> <p>Trail stops confirmed are: Stuart House will be the starting point who have confirmed Rachel Bennett will be available to help Golden Tree giving out maps, Wesley Church with help confirmed, Painters Arts & Crafts with help confirmed, the Tourist Information Centre who will need a helper and Mumma Mango who will need a helper. The owner of Occasions has expressed an interest and previously been a stop, but she is currently away so will need confirming when she's available. The final stop could be at the Cattle Market Car Park area, Rachel will speak to one of the traders and Safer Liskeard to see if they will take part. The trail will end with Cakey Tea at the Public Hall. The last trail to be given out advising that the Trail will end at 1pm. The volunteers on the trail training will be 25th November at the Liskerrett Centre 6-7pm.
