Ref: Footpath from Old Road to New Road

Dear Cllr Cassidy,

I am writing as chair of Liskeard Town Forum, which is a non-political body made up of residents and organisations with a shared ambition around the prosperity of Liskeard.

As you are probably aware Liskeard Town Forum agreed to support work to improve the paths and cycle ways around Liskeard. It is hoped that a meeting of the working group will be organised shortly, including the C&E working group members.

In the meantime, I thought C&E would like to note a resolution at the Forum to support a drive to improve the footpath link between Old Road and New Road at the bottom of Moorswater. At the moment the path from Old Road to New Road finishes with steps, which make them impractical to those with mobility scooters, bikes and prams. (See image below). The hill up to old road is steep and impractical. The steps and steep hill could limit access to Moorswater.

It is thought C&E would like to consider supporting efforts to improve this connection, as part of the footpath and cycle way work?
