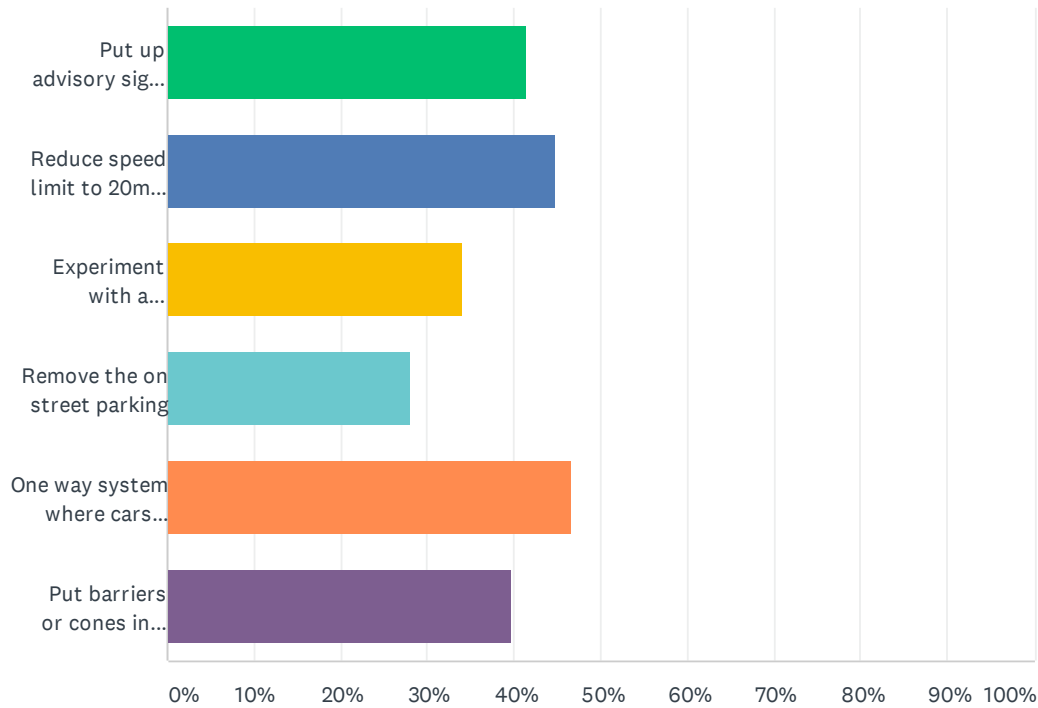

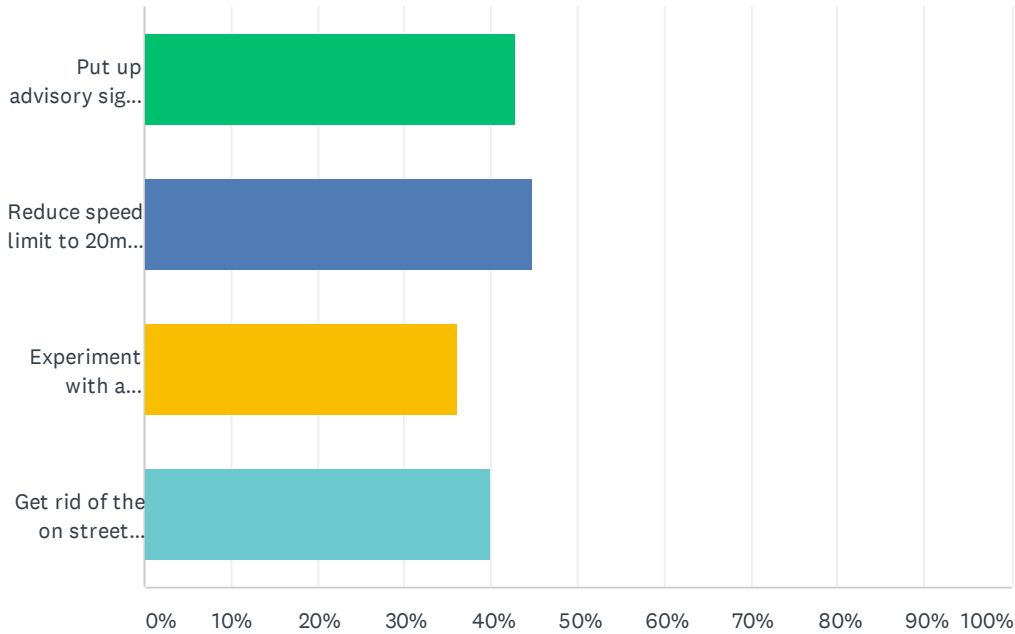

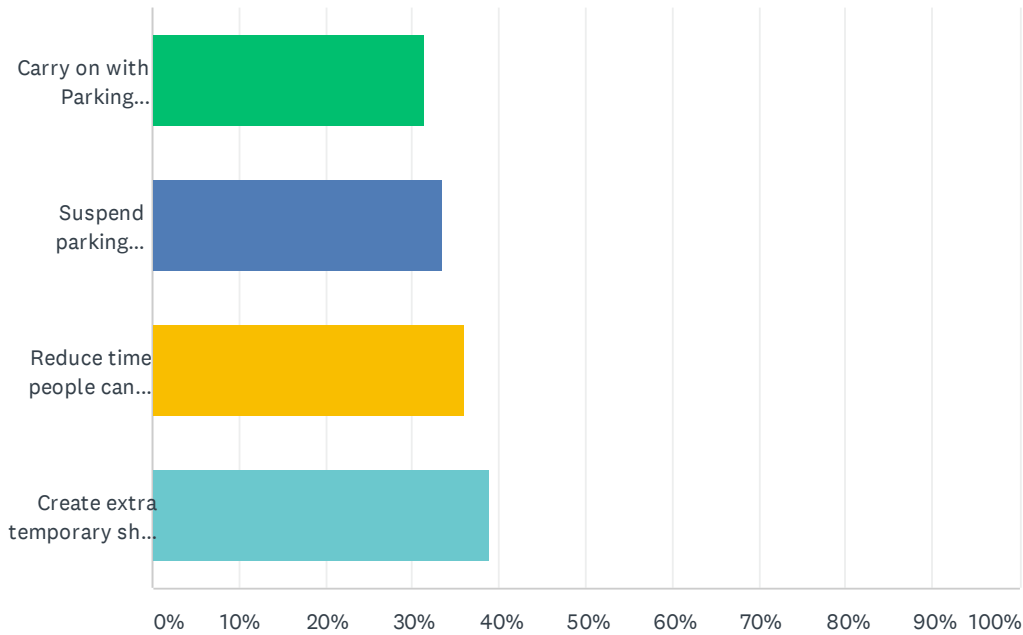

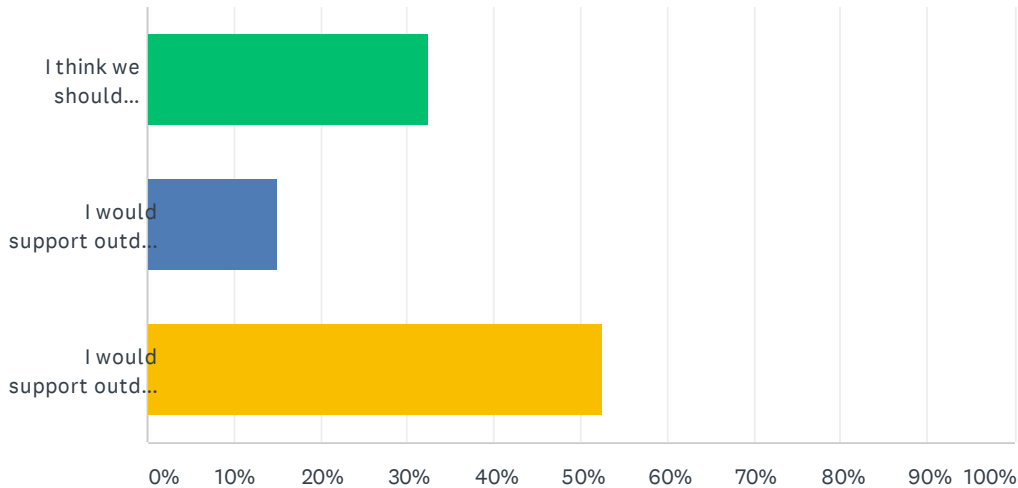

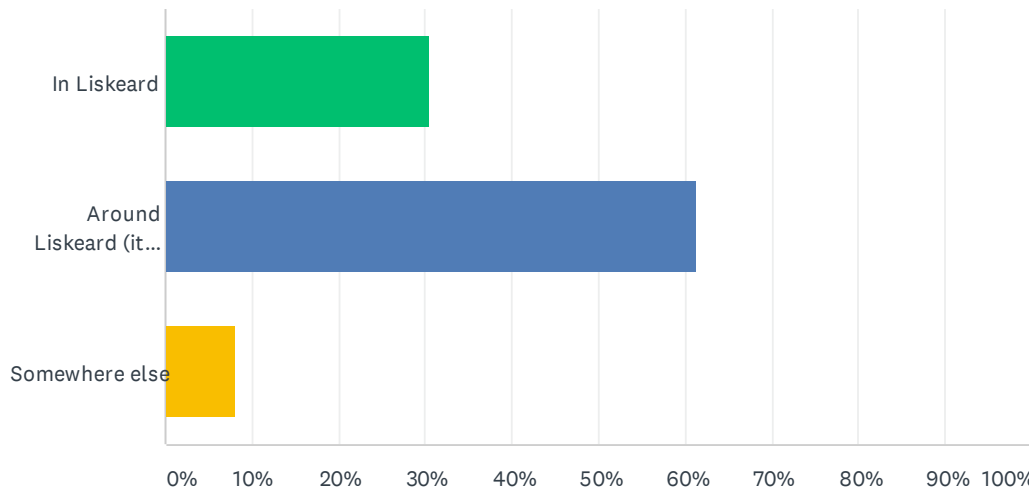

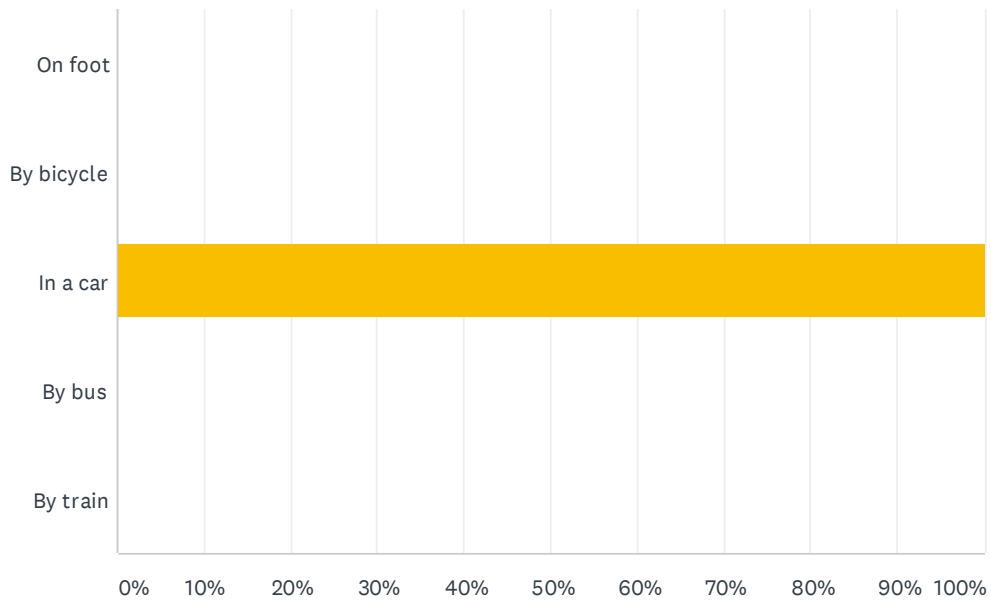

## Q6 How do you usually travel to the town centre?

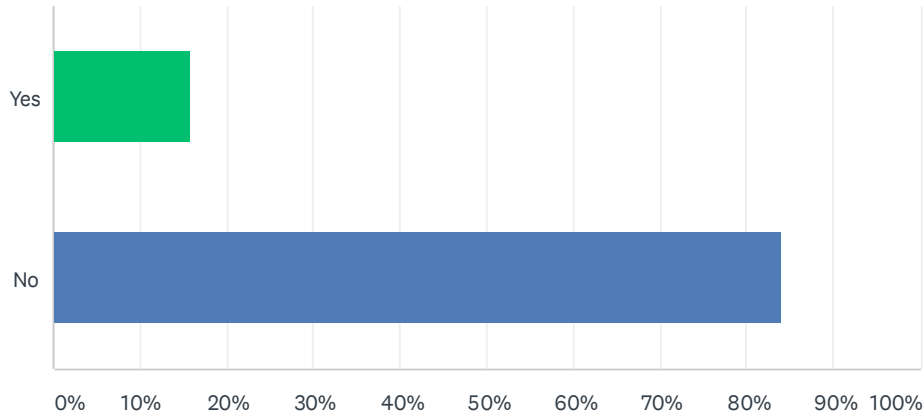

## Q7 Do you consider yourself to have a mobility problem?

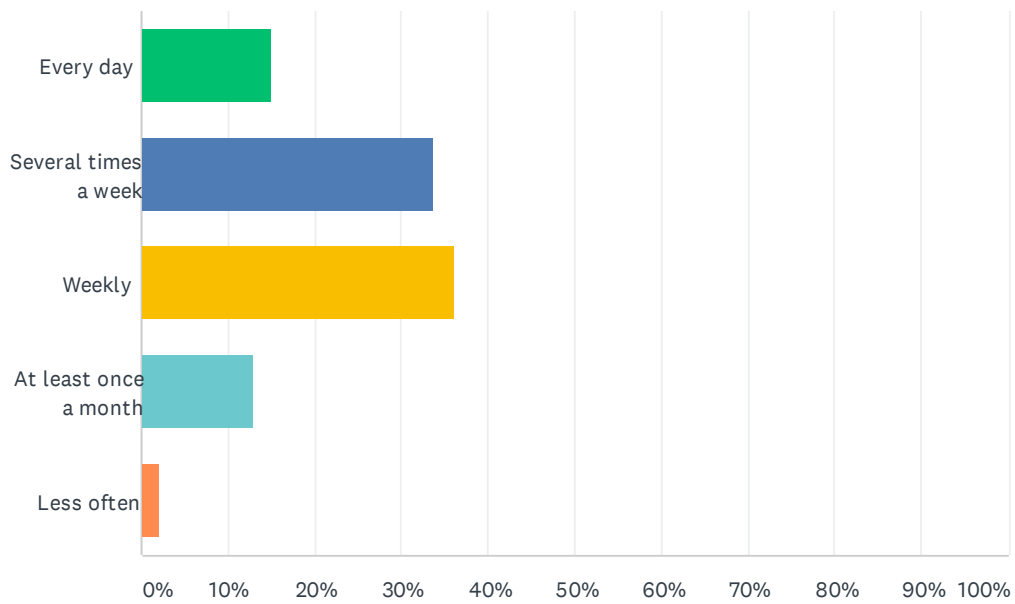

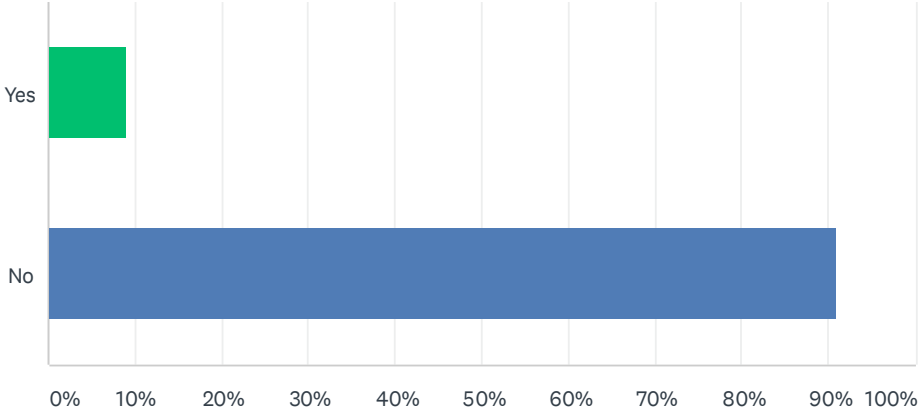
