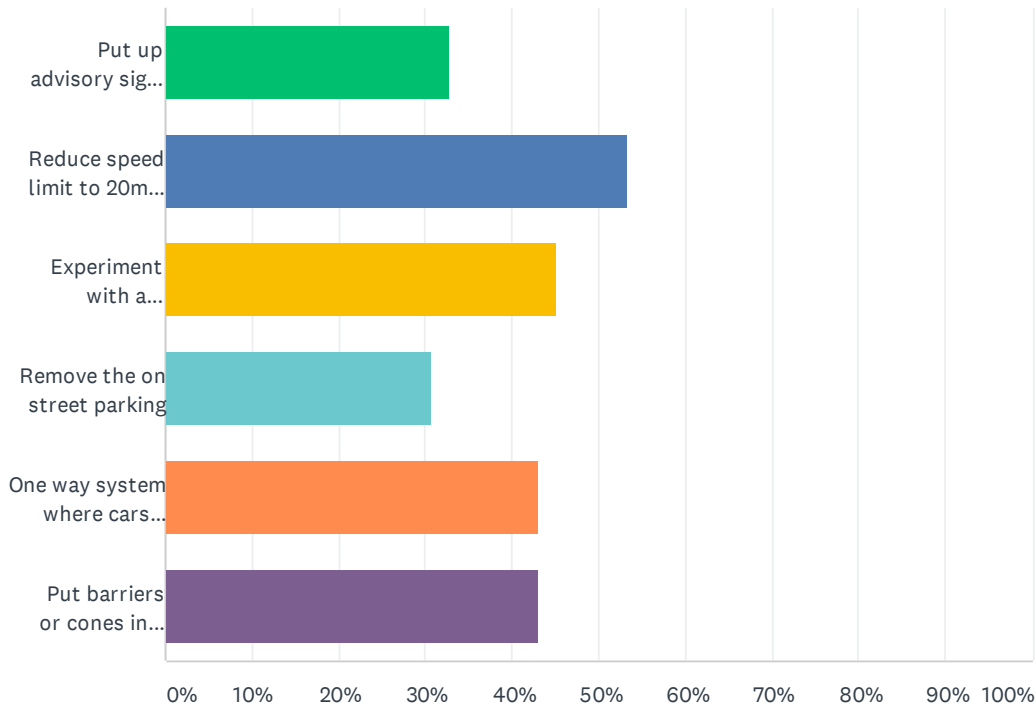

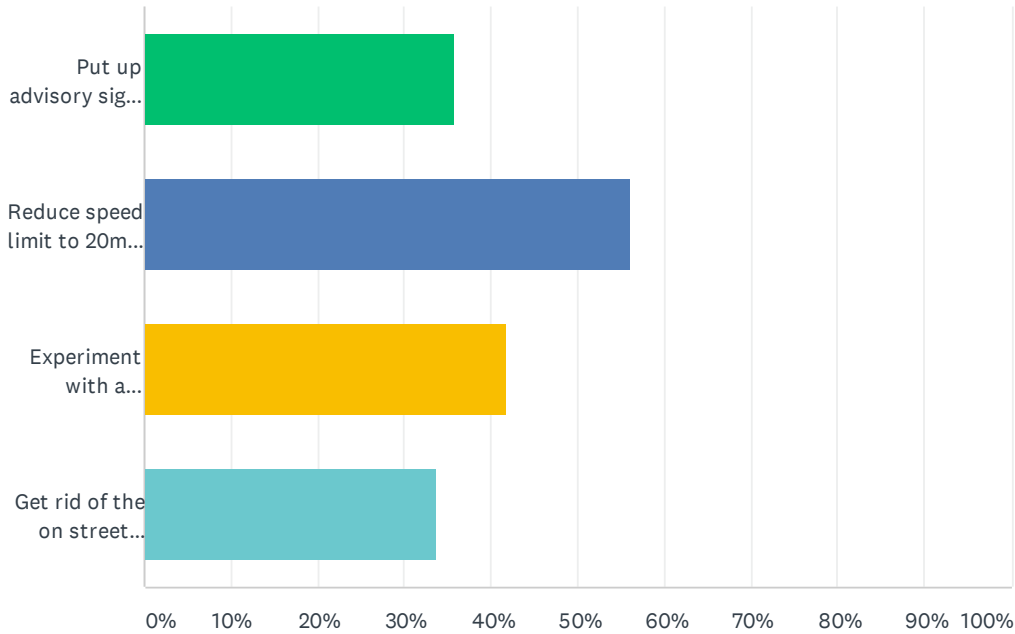

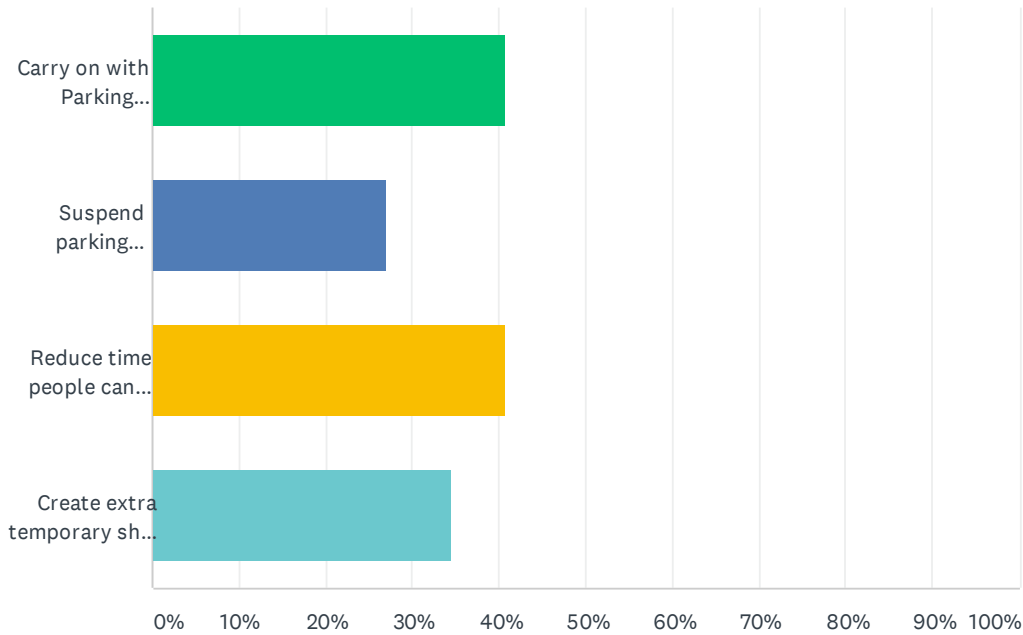

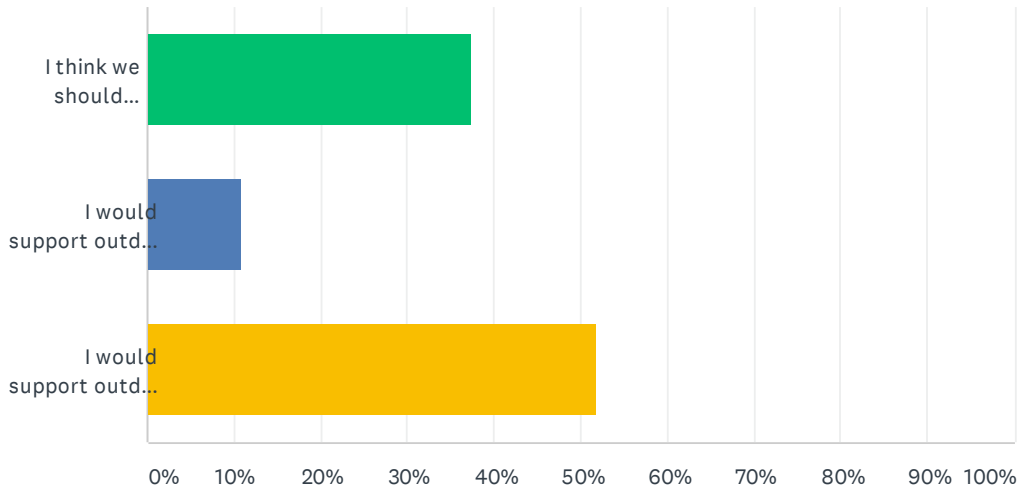

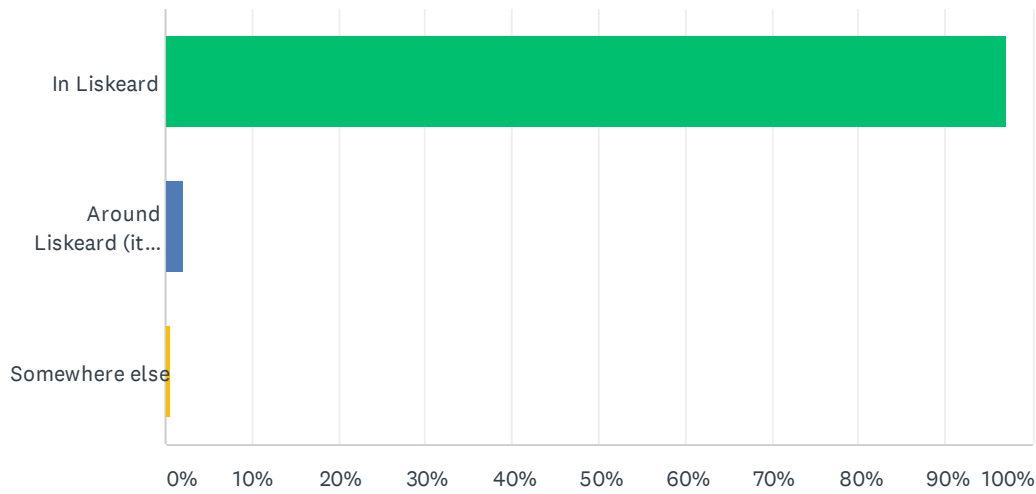

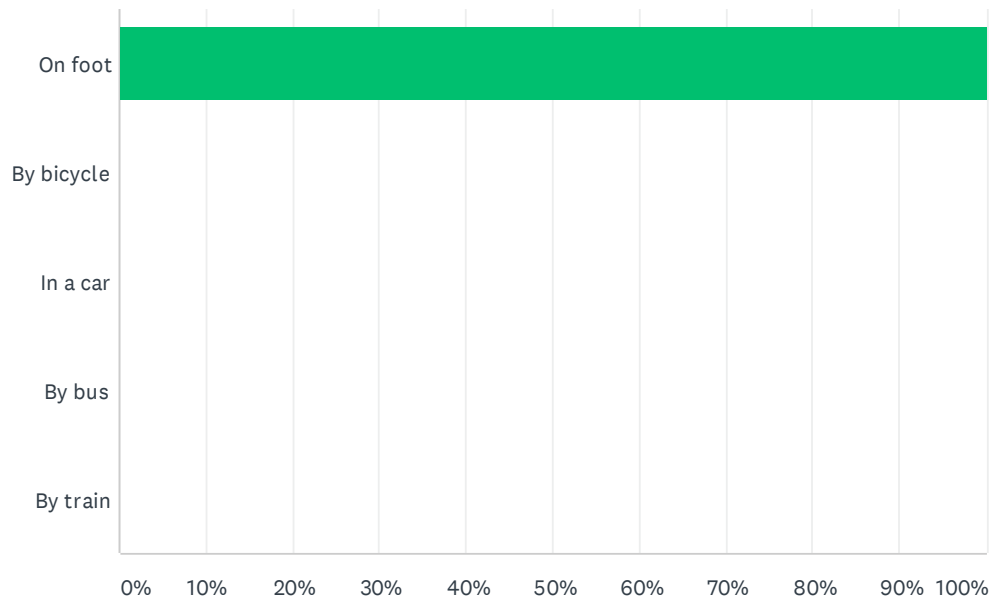

Q6 How do you usually travel to the town centre?

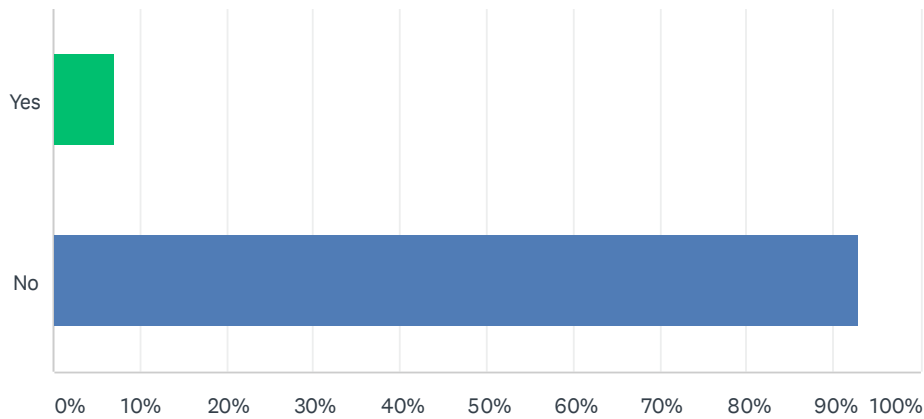

Q7 Do you consider yourself to have a mobility problem?

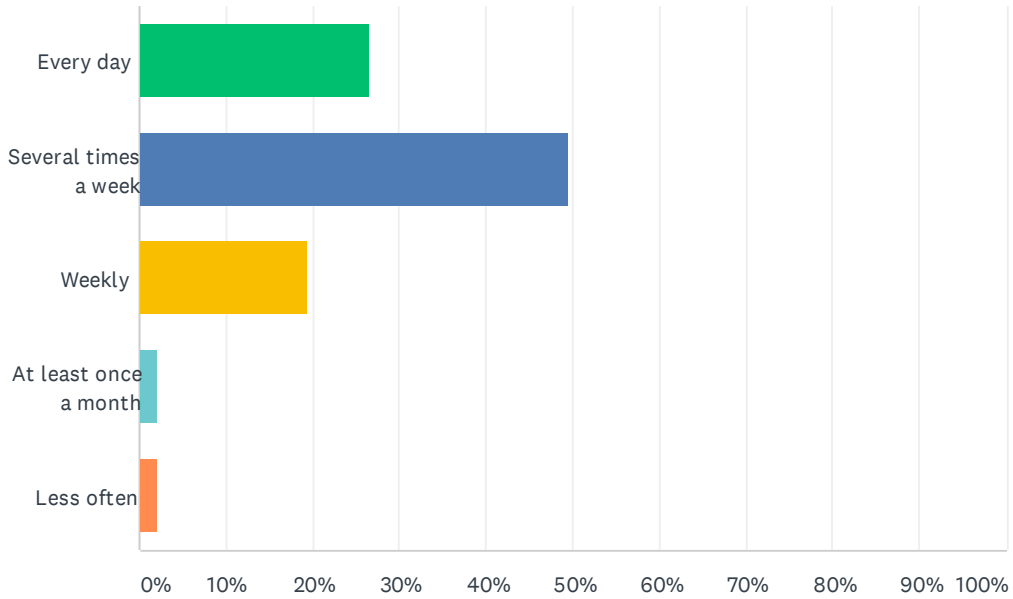

Q8 Before lockdown, how often did you visit Liskeard Town Centre?

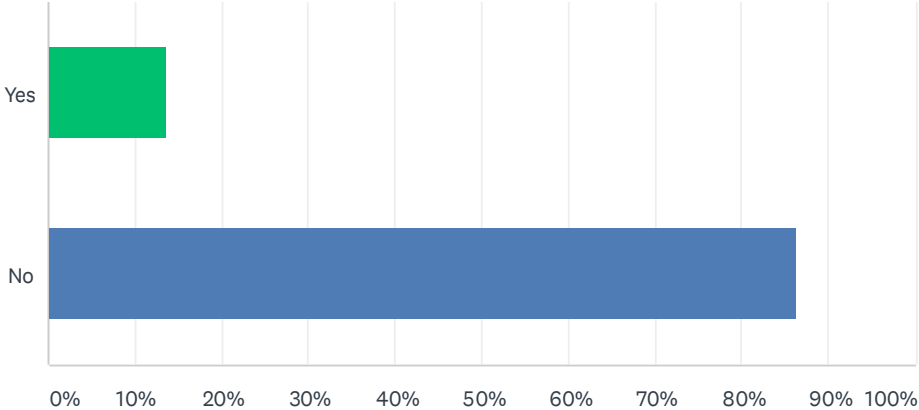
