1	<p><b>Welcome and Apologies</b></p> <p>Rachel welcomed everyone to the meeting.</p> <p>Apologies were received from Sally Hawken (Liskerrett Centre), Ann Kinahan (Market Makers), Leanne Llewellyn (Library) and Rev Mark Wade (St Martin's Church).</p>	
2	<p><b>Buildings Opening / Hosting Events</b></p> <p>Nick Brennan is available to create a community art feature at the Cattle Market Canopy. This will be incorporated into the Produce Market. The board has been promised by the developers working in the Market. The hoardings created prior to the Workshed development have not been located.</p> <p><b>Moghhe</b> – Brian advised that there was a possibility that the Library's projection of the town's history could be shown at Moghhe if the necessary permissions are obtained. This would need to be included in local publicity nearer the time.</p> <p><b>Epworth Studios</b> – have submitted their form.</p> <p><b>Boost House</b> – will open on 13<sup>th</sup> and will also host the Open Studios too.</p> <p><b>Stuart House</b> – Rachel Be will pass the insurance detail to Mandy.</p> <p><b>Museum</b> – Rachel Br will liaise with Sally and Iga to confirm what is happening about space for the Liskerrett display at the Museum. Iga will pass the upated wording to Rachel and Mandy to update their event details.</p> <p><b>Pipewell</b> –Mary Utton volunteered for the Pipewell on 13<sup>th</sup> with Councillor Lori Reid. Iga confirmed Museum volunteers are set for 20<sup>th</sup>.</p> <p><b>Sensory Trail</b> – The group went through the leaflet and suggested several amendments. This may be adapted for after the HOD event as a permanent trail of publicly open places. Rachel Be will let Rachel Br have an answer to the Stuart House question about the window. Rachel Br has made some wool rats which will be placed at some venues. 	<p>Mandy will check if the TIC has prisms for sale. 20 will be ordered for use on the Trail.</p> <p><b>Natural Beauty &amp; Beast Exhibition</b> – Rachel advised that the project had slipped back and would not be ready for this year. Maybe next year.</p> <p><b>Trewithan House</b> – Rachel Br had visited and had good meeting with the owner.</p> <p><b>Greenbank House</b> – It's not known yet if taking part. Could be a last minute addition with local publicity.</p> <p><b>The Library</b> – Brian has had no further contact regarding a talk. The Library will be a quiet space. The café will be taking part in Taste the Past. Rathik will be in there reading architecture books.</p> <p><b>The Story of Emily</b> – no response has been received.</p> <p><b>The Workshed</b> – no response has been received.</p> <p><b>Taste the Past</b> – Stuart House, the Hub at Liskerrett, the Hive, Moghhe, The T Garden and the Library are confirmed as taking part. Rachel Br will speak to the Fat Frog and Ben's Plaice again to confirm them. The Cornish Pudding Co may take part if they have time. Barnecutts may take part. Rumours and Bean aren't taking part. The participants will have food from the era that their building was built and Brian will produce a poster showing historic information about their building. 3	<p><b>Publicity</b></p> <p>The group went through the main Liskeard Unlocked leaflet in detail and amendments were agreed to be sent through to the designer.</p> <p>The leaflet will be available for Liskeard Show and can be on the Town Council, Museum and Churches Together stands.</p> <p>A draft social media plan was discussed and updated.</p> <p><b>Schools</b> – It was suggested that local primary schools be notified about the event as soon as the autumn term starts. They can also be tagged in the event, particularly the Trail. This to include those in adjoining villages.</p> <p><b>Rachel</b> advised that HOD had been in touch about our Ukraine event last year and our international collaboration as a case study. We will share the info with the group when they have more details to share.</p> <p>Mandy encouraged participants to send through many photos (labelled), especially as the HOD website didn't want to accept some, so having a few to choose from could help.</p>
