Choirs – Sally has spoken to the Community Choir who would like to perform again before the tree lights are switched on. They also offered a small group who could possibly perform at the Museum before the event if space allows with some rooms being closed during the time. Lizzie will speak to Iga. The Library also offered to host the Choir who wouldn't need to have microphones there. Performing at the Canopy will also be investigated.
