<u>Town Council Objectives 2017 – 2018</u>

Full Council

• To achieve Local Council Award Scheme Quality status – Budget £80 (by February 2018)

Finance & General Purposes Committee

• To research and develop upgrade proposals for the town's CCTV system in conjunction with the Devon and Cornwall Crime Commissioner – Budget £10,000 (by March 2018)

Facilities Committee

- To accept the transfer of a piece of land at Eastern Avenue, and research with the Cornwall Council who own the adjoining land, the creation of a footpath – Budget £2,500 (by March 2018)
- To establish an online booking system for the hire of facilities in the Public Hall complex, to increase usage Budget £410 (April 2017)

Communications & Engagement Committee

• To work with other local groups to produce a quarterly community magazine delivered to households within the town - Budget £4,000 (June 2017)

<u>Planning</u>

• To progress the Draft Neighbourhood Plan to the next stage of 'Plan Proposals Submitted' – Budget £7,700 plus nominated reserves brought forward of £26,959 (July 2017)
