### c) <u>Liskeard Unlocked (September 2024)</u>

### (i) to receive the notes from the first planning meeting on 19 February 2024

This year's theme was routes, networks and connections, and Liskeard would be focusing on our mining heritage and twinning connections.

## (ii) to update on conversations with our twinned towns on joint working for European Heritage Open Days and a meeting with Quimperle in Geilenkirchen

A virtual meeting had taken place with Kopychyntsi who were keen to share dance, food, singing and storytelling. This would be in the form of parallel events taking place and shared virtually. Here this is likely to focus around a traditional Crying the Neck and dancing around the town and at an evening event.

Quimperle have already chosen their theme for European Heritage Open Days which is a focus on World War II, but would like to plan with us for 2025. However, in October they have celebrations for the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of a traditional music group and we are looking at how we could share Cornish and Breton music. The people from Quimperle involved in European Heritage Open Days will not be travelling to Geilenkirchen.

# d) Nadelik Lyskerrys (December 2024) - to receive verbal feedback from the first planning meeting on Tuesday 12 March 2024 at 1.30pm at the Liskerrett Centre

It had been agreed the main Liskeard Lights Up event would take place on Saturday 30 November 2024 in a similar format to 2023. The lantern parade would be dependent on funding. The library would be involved again, although they may not be able to repeat last year's projection mapping. A better public address system was needed and improved communication to ensure people know what is happening after the parade, light switch on and fireworks.
