Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984)

Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Cornwall Council intends to make the above order in exercise of its powers under 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by traffic over an area of highway being Castle Street Liskeard between its junctions with Castle Hill and Church Street North. The Council is satisfied that the Order is needed because works are being executed on or near the road to replace covers and repair signal loops

The Order will come into operation on 24th June 2019 and the works are expected to be completed by the 28th June 2019. The prohibition will be in force between the hours of 1900 and 0700 on a daily basis weekdays only

Nothing in this order will apply to emergency services, traffic associated with the works required within the highway specified above, any vehicle being used for the purposes of an undertaker in an emergency, such as loss of utility supplies, cyclists and anything done with the permission of or at the discretion of a police officer.

Pedestrian and Vehicular access to residents and businesses will be maintained.
