Western Greyhound replacement bus services

Dear Town and Parish Councils,

The Council Passenger Transport team have worked tirelessly today with the bus industry to attempt to arrange alternative services for those provided formerly by Western Greyhound.

Four companies have agreed to provide the majority of services from Monday 16 March and so it is hoped that, for the main part, disruption to the general public will be kept to a minimum.

Please see attached a map and list of the replacement bus services, which I hope you find useful.

There will still be some former Western Greyhound buses on the road, from Monday onwards, but they will not be operated by Western Greyhound.

All Real Time Passenger Information signs (RTPI) have been switched off to avoid confusion while the service timetables are being updated.
