Community Governance Review

Cornwall Council are currently undertaking a Community Governance Review for the whole of Cornwall - the first in 35 years.

This includes reviewing the boundaries between parishes to make sure they are in the right place to fit with how communities are developing.

In order to simplify matters for future development and town planning, Liskeard Town Council is proposing an amendment to the boundary between Dobwalls and Trewidland parish and itself, to take in the town sewage works and the remainder of the Moorswater Industrial estate and areas under consideration for development, which is generally already assumed to fall within Liskeard.

The proposed change would transfer a small number of properties, including yours, from Dobwalls and Trewidland Parish to Liskeard Town. For residential properties this would result in a change in your usual polling station and council tax billing as follows based on 2019/2020 information:

* There may be a further reduction for band A homes if you qualify for disabled relief

For a Band D property this would mean an additional charge of £2.33 per week.

We are meeting with Dobwalls and Trewidland Parish Council again on 19 June and would welcome any comments you wish to make, by email or letter to, by Monday 17 June 2019.

Final requests for any changes to the current governance arrangements must be made to Cornwall Council by 17 July 2019. Any changes agreed will not come into effect until April 2021.
