Who in the Town will benefit?	<p>This project will benefit young members of our community who have an interest and passion for engineering. It will develop their experiences of working within a team in a real world situation and involve them in problem solving and developing skills and knowledge of sustainable energies and environmentally conscious engineering.</p> <p>The young people involved in this project are the talent base to continue and build on the local manufacturing and engineering businesses. Furthermore, this project could generate positive PR for Liskeard on the local and national stage.</p>
A brief description of your project	<p>National charity Greenpower organise an annual electric car challenge which requires students, guided by their teachers and an industry mentor, to design, build and then race an electric car. Holding events at weekends, at major motor circuits around the UK, ensures excellent attendance from the general public who witness the amazing vehicles, focus and team work evident at these events.</p> <p>Since the first event in 1999, Greenpower has expanded significantly and now works with 500 schools and over 1000 students around the UK. A few schools in Cornwall are involved and Liskeard, as the specialist Engineering College in Cornwall, now wishes to enter the fray. This will give a group of students interested in engineering as a career, the opportunity to test and develop their skills through an engaging and challenging project, undertaken in their spare time.</p> <p>This essentially requires the school to purchase a one-off kart "kit", to customise and specialise their kit using scientific and</p>

	engineering principles, and then to compete nationally. Once the initial kart kit is purchased, year on year smaller scale investment to design and re-build the car and attend competition venues are sustainable through continued sponsorship and local support.
