

Image upload terms of use

It is your responsibility to ensure that any images or video you submit have been taken with the consent of anyone who is identifiable in that image or the consent of their parent/guardian if they are under 18 and that they are aware that their photograph may be published on the Heritage Open Days website, the Heritage Open Days social media channels, print or a combination of these, run by the National Trust.

You must ensure that if you are not the photographer, videographer or copyright holder of any images you upload on to the National Trust's Heritage Open Days website for publication on the website, Heritage Open Days social media channels, print or a combination of these, you have the copyholder's permission to publish them on this website.

You confirm that:

- Any images you submit were taken at, refer to or represent a site or event taking part in Heritage Open Days.
- Any information you supply is factually correct (to the best of your knowledge) and/or that uncertainties are made clear.
- You understand that Heritage Open Days and the National Trust have no obligation to publish any visual media or written information you submit.

You will retain copyright and moral rights in your uploaded images, however, by submitting an image, you:

- Grant the National Trust the right to publish and display the images on the Heritage Open Days website, the Heritage Open Days social media channels, print or a combination of these, run by the National Trust within a five-year period after submission;
- Agree that the National Trust may use the images for the purpose of promoting and marketing Heritage Open Days in print or online media within a five-year period after submission.

The National Trust will ensure the photographer or video maker will always be credited whenever his or her image is used on the Heritage Open Days website, and as far as possible in other media.

Once your content has been published, if another user reports your content as not in accordance with the terms of use as set out above, we can remove any of your content without further notice to you.
