Firstly I'd like to pay tribute to all of the key workers who live or work in Liskeard, who have kept things going through some very difficult times.

We always knew Liskeard was a caring and active community and we've seen that very clearly as so many organisations and individuals have stepped up to help each other. Thank you, if you've been able to help.

In March the Town Council set up an emergency social fund and so far we've given more than £12,500 to organisations helping our community providing free food, making masks and visors and finding ways to entertain people at home.
