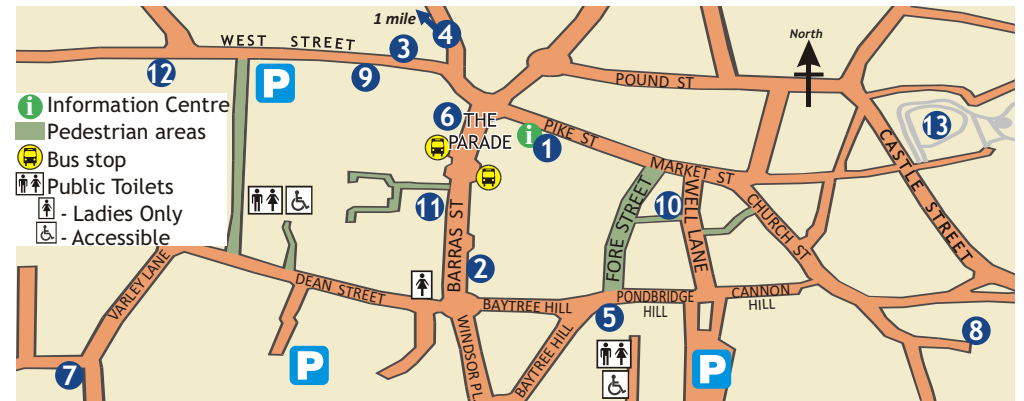
View this historic building, the site of Martin's Court miners' cottages and the ancient pilgrimage site of Our Lady of Liskeard.
