In December 2017 the final livestock sale was held at Liskeard cattle market creating a rare opportunity to re-think the future of this key area in the heart of our town.

Previous consultations have shown that there is strong community support for redeveloping the site and work has been ongoing to explore potential options. The Liskeard Neighbourhood Plan encourages the development of, “a mix of uses that support the vitality and viability of the town centre (Cattle Market Policy TC4)”

Cornwall Council is committed to working closely with the Liskeard community to enable the ambitions set out in the Neighbourhood Plan to be achieved and has secured central Government support for this Charrette exercise with a dedicated specialist team led by JTP. This is a great opportunity to build upon the work we have been doing over the last two years, create a clear vision and enable us to take the project forward.

What is a Charrette?

A Charrette is an interactive planning and design event which takes place over a number of days. It is an opportunity to for residents and local stakeholders to share their local knowledge ideas and work with experts to create a new vision through facilitated workshops, walkabouts and hands-on planning groups.

Participation is on a drop-in basis – there is no need to pre-register – you can stay for a short while, a few hours or the whole event.

Report back presentation

After the public workshop days, the team will use the information gathered to draw up a vision for the cattle market site, including an illustrative masterplan. This will be presented back to the local community on Tuesday evening, 12 March.
