<u>Liskeard Town Council – Services</u> The Town Council operates a range of buildings and services for the people of Liskeard. These include the provision of letting rooms at the Public Hall, The Guildhall, the Museum, the Tourist Information Centre, the town centre C.C.T.V. system, the Rapsons Field Multi Use Games Area, Thorn Park, the Pengover and Lake Lane Allotments and three sets of Toilets. We also organise the cleaning of Bus Shelters together with the maintenance of the War Memorial, the Fountain and the Ancient Pipe Well.

Budget and Precept Setting 2016/2017 The Town Council has decided to limit its increase in the precept to 2% or £7,632 more than in the previous financial year. The Town Council has decided to allocate the additional money raised as follows:

- £5,500 increase in the grants budget to support projects put forward by community groups
- \pounds 1,000 increase in the elections provision budget to help pay for the holding of the elections
- £1,000 increase in IT provision to help with the introduction of Paperless Planning

The number of houses within the town boundary has increased from 2,765 to 2,833. This has the impact of spreading the Town Council precept over a greater number of households. By the Cornwall Council supplied precept calculator the net effect on a Band D property is that the element of their bill that is made up of the Town Council's precept will fall by -.58p a year.

<u>Liskeard Town Council – Projects 2016/2017</u> In considering the budget setting for 2016/2017, the Town Council transferred funds from other budget heads for completed projects and has been able to plan the following new projects and service items.

- £25,000 has been placed in the 2016/2017 budget for a Public Hall Refreshment Room Refurbishment project.
- £4,500 has been placed in the budget line for weed spraying as this activity will not be funded by Cornwall Council.
- £2,000 Car Park Trials the Town Council helped to support the Christmas 2015 free parking initiative and is minded to make a budget line provision to assist again in this.
- £10,000 Devolution Projects to support projects and services to be devolved by Cornwall Council to Liskeard Town Council.
