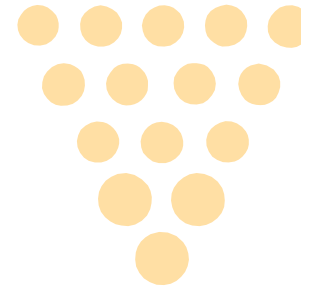

## Working safely

Please be aware of the following hazards while the Reclamite treatment is taking place.

- Surface will be slippery for a period whilst the crew are working on there.
- It is important that all vehicles cyclists' pedestrians and pets do not get into the works area
- Any material that gets onto a vehicle can be removed using readily available car shampoo.
- There will be some dust once the traffic starts to use the carriageway again.
- We will return and use a mechanical sweeper to remove any excess aggregate.
- Observe advisory speed limits as shown on the signs.

Please be kind to the workforce and observe any signs or safety fencing that is in place. Our teams are working within the guidelines laid out by the government for construction works, and we are proud to be able to continue to keep on top of our commitments to improve road standards across the county.

## Notifications

Our work is weather dependant and may be delayed by cold temperatures & heavy rain.

During the ongoing situation with COVID-19 we will continue to carry out our programmed resurfacing works while we have the available resource and material to do so.

However, if the situation changes it may result in works being postponed or cancelled at short notice and will do our best to update the advance notice boards on our sites.
