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389/16 CORRESPONDENCE

a) <u>PA17/00020/PREAPP - Pearce Fine Homes Ltd, Land off Woodgate</u> <u>Road</u>

The developers, Pearce Fine Homes Ltd outlined their proposals for the site at this pre-application stage. The committee drew their attention to concerns on lack of public transport, traffic, lack of pavements, drainage and that the Draft Neighbourhood Plan had not given a high sustainability rating to this site as suitable for housing development. In addition, they highlighted a desire to retain existing woodland and trees, and consider the provision of orchards/allotments/children's play equipment within the development as well as off-site open space.

b) <u>Street Names – Former Magistrates Court, Culverland Road and</u> <u>Timberlee, Tregay Lane</u>

The developers, Mansion Developments SW Ltd had proposed 'Maple Grove' for the Magistrates Court site. This was rejected by the committee as it had no local ties. 'Culverwood Close' was suggested as an alternative.

'Timberlee Close' was proposed for the Timberlee site, and this was accepted by the Committee.

c) <u>Community Infrastructure Levy – Comments are sought on the</u> proposed CIL Rates and the viability assumptions made in determining <u>these rates.</u>

Arising from the discussion, the following points were made:

The CIL was to provide infra-structure in the area collected – if this cannot be collected in some zones, how will this be provided where it is most needed?

A Neighbourhood Plan was to have increased the Town Council share from 15 - 25%. However, as the proposed rate on housing in this area is ± 0 we will not benefit from all the work carried out.

Information was needed on how decisions on spending of the monies raised from CIL will be made, and who will make them. Would there be local community input to this?

Following discussion, it was felt that a fairer distribution of the monies would be more appropriate, maybe involving positive discrimination,

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where more affluent areas support those less well off.

Councillor J Shrubsole, with the Support Services Manager will draft a reply.

d) <u>Advertising Banners on approach to the Town – To discuss and agree</u> <u>an approach</u>

Since the last discussion of this item, further contact has been made with those displaying banners, and more have been removed.

Details were circulated of arrangements at Callington Town Council which regulates the displaying of banners to advertise events on railings owned by the council. A similar arrangement would resolve this issue, but as the Town Council do not own the fences in question it would prove difficult.

An arrangement which limited banner displays to events, or Liskeard based organisations and businesses would be favourable.
