Non-material amendment in relation to decision notice PA17/04823 dated 04.07.2017:

Retrospective permission to alter the road surface treatments, by changing paving to tarmac

It was noted that while the paving was more aesthetically pleasing, residents reported that it was more slippery during the recent cold weather.

PA22/10699 – Laura Viant, Cattle Market Entry, Fairpark Road

Creation of a three and two storey linked building, providing accommodation for Safe and Well, Department for Work and Pensions, Adult Day Services, Cornwall Council, Family Hub, and Adult Education Departments

The committee noted and shared some of the concerns about the loss of car parking. However, the development offered a significant positive commercial impact with jobs in the town centre increasing footfall and supporting the viability and vitality of the town centre. The new development would secure jobs and services in Liskeard, streamlining services and making some more accessible. Enquiries would be made at the next Liskeard Redevelopment Group meeting about providing replacement parking elsewhere on the site.

PA22/10703 – C/o Mr Tom Watson, National Grid Electricity Distribution (South West) Plc, Units at Lamellion, Station Road

Proposed new electricity connections as per attached plan 442686. Works requiring Section 37 consent are between existing poles 45SDFB3 and 45SDFC1. The work involves changing the existing poles on a like for like basis, adding a lazy leg pole at 45SDFC1 to upgrade the pole mounted transformer and associated plant and to run a third wire between 45SDFB3 and 45SDFC1. The 3rd wire works only affect the one span between 45SDFB3 and 45SDFC1 over the railway line near Coombe Junction
