Temporary Prohibition of Vehicular Traffic Order 2018

Notice is hereby given that Cornwall Council intends to make the above order in exercise of its powers under section 16A of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic over an area of highway being Dean Street between the junctions of Fairpark Road and Baytree Hill, and Baytree Hill, , Fairpark Road, Barras Street, The Parade, Pike Street, Fore Street, Market Approach, Greenbank Road, Higher Lux Street, Castle Street, Church Street, Church Street North, Church Street, Market Street Liskeard for their entire length as highlighted in red on the plan attached to this Order

The Order shall come into operation at 18:30 on the 20th June 2018 and continue until 20:00 on the 23rd June 2018. The restrictions imposed by this order shall remain in force on such days and during such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. In this order "traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type described or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Council is satisfied that the order is needed to facilitate the holding of the following relevant event **Liskeard Carnival and Flora Dance**

Liskeard Carnival Flora Dance: 20th June 2018 (18:30 to 19:30 hours)

Dean Street between the junctions of Fairpark Road and Baytree Hill, and Baytree Hill, Fairpark Road, Barras Street, The Parade, Pike Street, Fore Street for their entire length

Liskeard Carnival Day: 23rd June 2018 (18:30 to 20:00 hours)

Market Approach, Barras Street, The Parade, Greenbank Road, Higher Lux Street, Castle Street, Church Street North, Church Street, Market Street and Pike Street for their entire length

While the Order is in operation traffic, including bicycle movement, along the highway specified in paragraph 1, will be temporarily restricted. No personnel, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle or pedal cycle to enter on, proceed or wait in the length of road described above.

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

Any police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard vehicle, or any personnel on official duty, or any vehicle or person authorised by and with the permission of Cornwall Council.

Any vehicle being used for the purposes of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitate the bringing of vehicles into the section of highway to which this order applies.

Traffic associated with the event required within the highway specified above.
