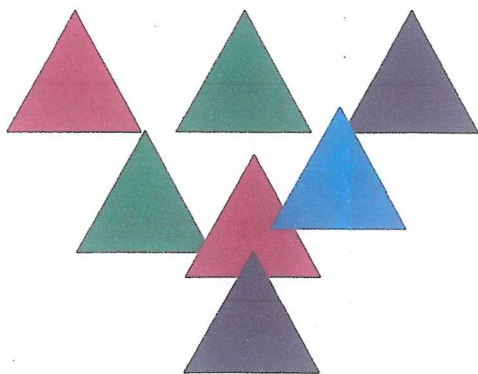

The Liskeard Triangle centre provides information and support to people affected by cancer. The centre aims to support anyone affected by cancer, whether it is patients, their families or carers. The Liskeard Triangle Centre was set up to allow local people to access support in their community hospital.

The Triangle centre provides a friendly, professional and welcoming environment for people to 'drop in' and discuss any concerns they have. The centre provides a supportive environment where people can talk freely and be listened to, whilst also being offered the support and information they need.

Advice & Information

The centre is staffed by professionals who can provide information on a range of topics, including information about treatment and ways of coping with a cancer diagnosis. There is also a range of leaflets and booklets for people to take away.

Complementary Therapy

The centre can offer a number of complementary therapies to both patients and carers and these can be useful in aiding relaxation. Therapies offered include:

- Reiki
- Reflexology
- Massage

Appointments with other professionals such as clinical nurse specialists, counsellors and benefits advisors can be arranged by the Triangle centre staff if required.

Living With & Beyond Cancer Service

The Living With & Beyond Cancer service (LWBC) is a new service set up to meet the needs of those 'living with and beyond cancer' and builds upon the work already done by the Triangle centre. The team is able to provide support to people affected by cancer on a range of concerns, including:

- Physical needs
- Emotional, psychological, social & spiritual needs
- Financial information & advice
- Diet & Nutrition

The LWBC team is available to support patients, their families and carers in a way in which meets their needs and can offer the opportunity to discuss any concerns they have at the Triangle centre.
