

Update from Liskeard Town Council – Barras Street pavement improvement works

We understand the difficulties caused by the roadworks in the town centre, and have been in communication with Cornwall Council who have given us the following update:

We apologise for the inconvenience to residents and businesses whilst these works are being carried out.

The works in Barras Street outside Wetherspoon's are being carried out by Cornwall Council to make safety improvements for pedestrians through this part of the town centre.

We're replacing the surfacing to improve the footway with new granite kerbing and a slabbed surface.

This is a very busy and restricted junction which means we have to use three-way temporary traffic lights in order to protect the public via the temporary walkway in the road.

The work has to be carried out in small confined sections in order to maintain access to the adjacent businesses, as well as keeping pedestrians safe.

All the car parks remain open, so customers are still able to park and walk to the town centre as usual.

We understand progress has suffered some delays due to the poor weather, and Cormac are now working towards completion by 12th November, and looking to work Saturdays and Sundays and longer days onsite to be out of the town centre sooner, but this is weather dependant and further heavy rain will impact on progress as it has to date.
